Green Scene: Kellner Garden lets you see food being grown

More people are becoming conscious about where the food comes from and one local garden is letting folks in to see how the food is being grown.

Local farmers are inviting you to join them through community supported agriculture.

Members can buy a share at the beginning of the growing season and share in the harvest all season long.

Kellner Back Acre Garden is a former dairy farm turned community supported Agriculture or CSA. The farm supports about 100 people.

They run the season for about 21 weeks, and whatever is harvested during a week, members get part of that harvest.

Beyond produce there are grass fed beef cows, turkeys, and chickens.

For people who want to eat local and healthy, it's peace of mind.
